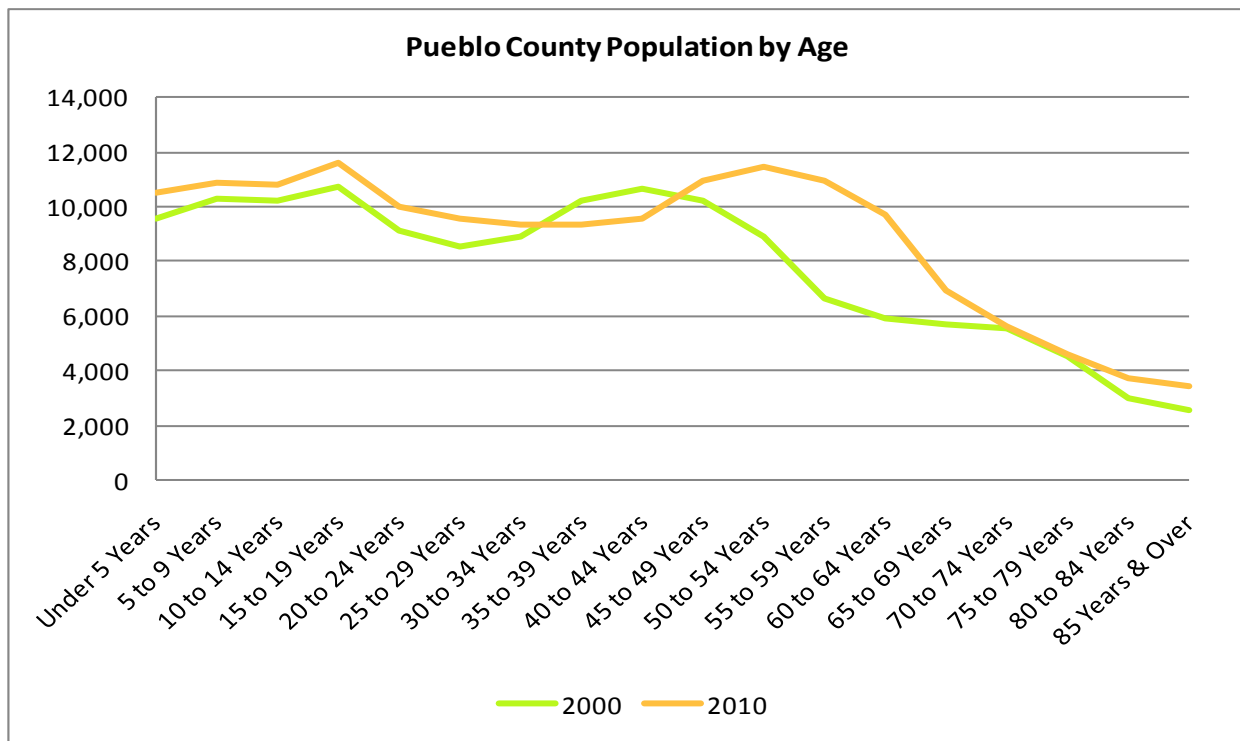

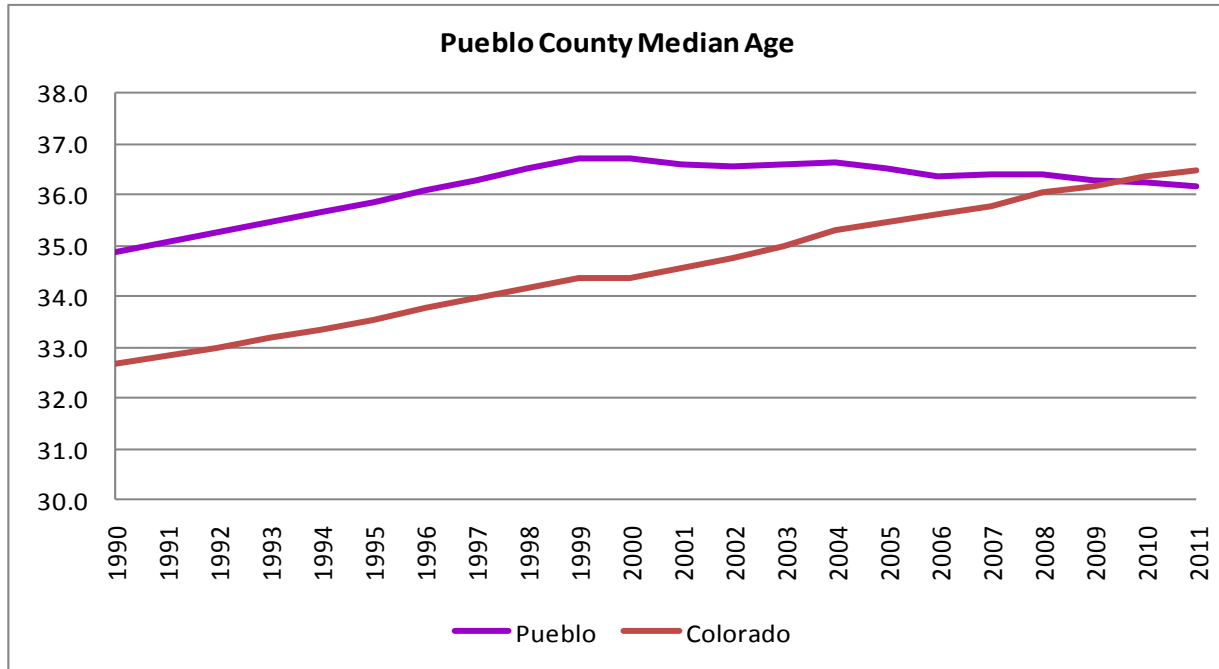
Population by Age

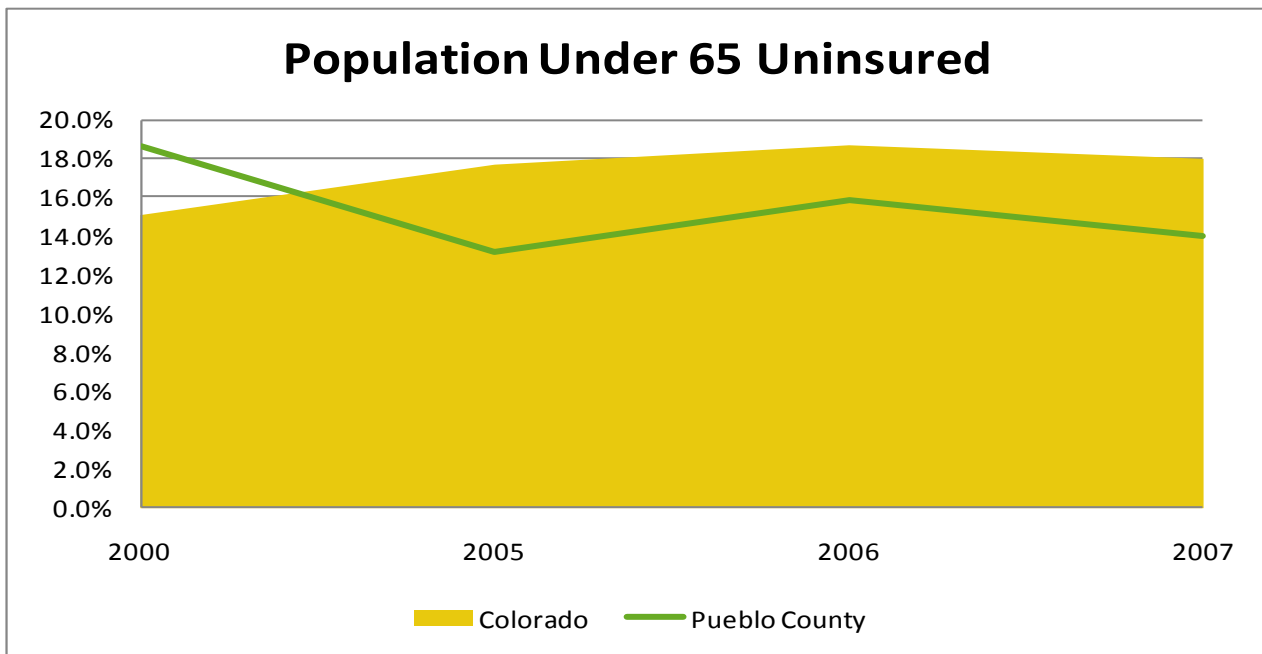

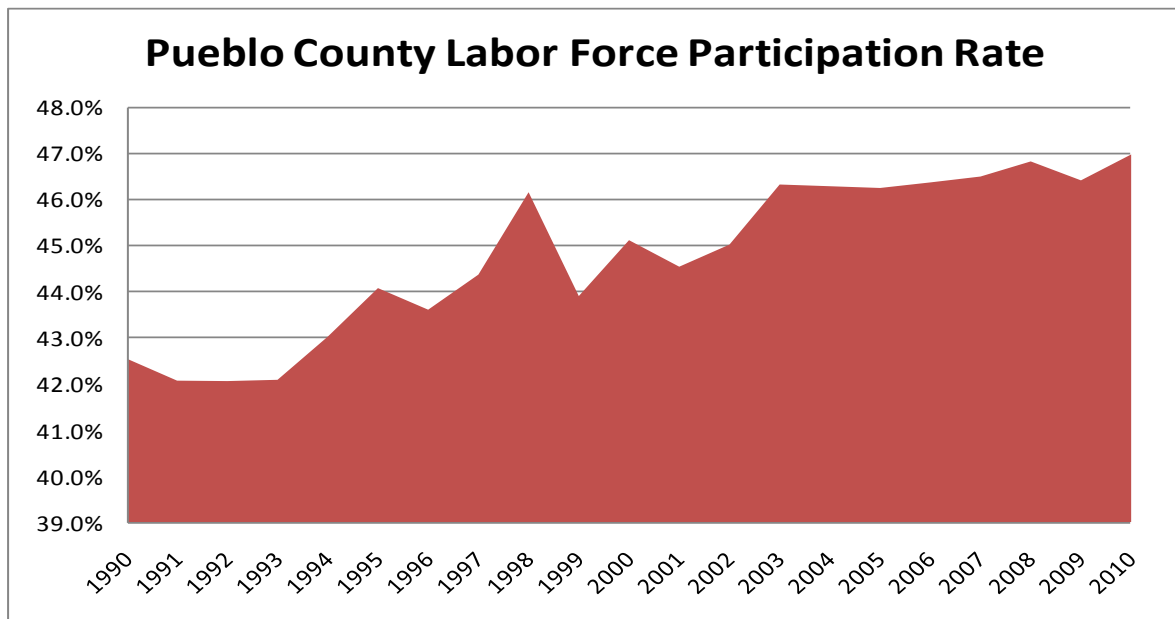

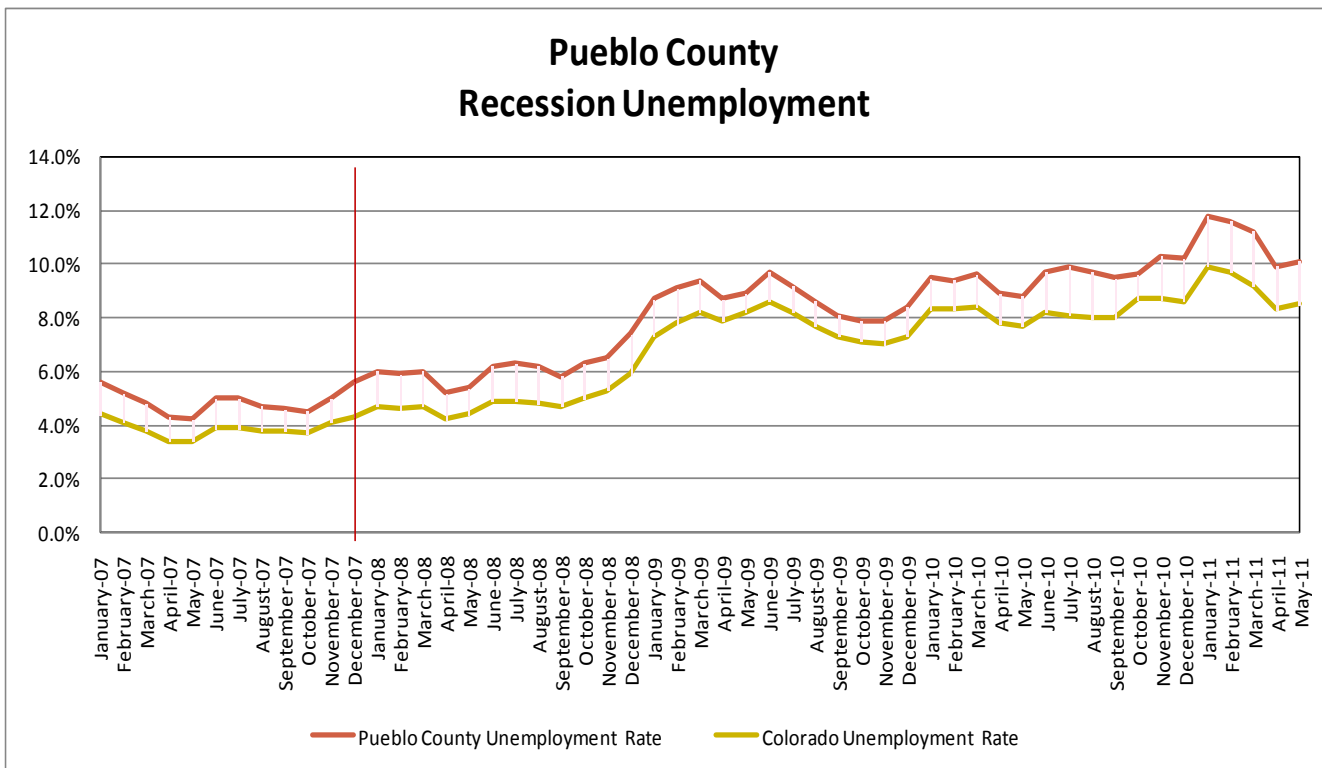
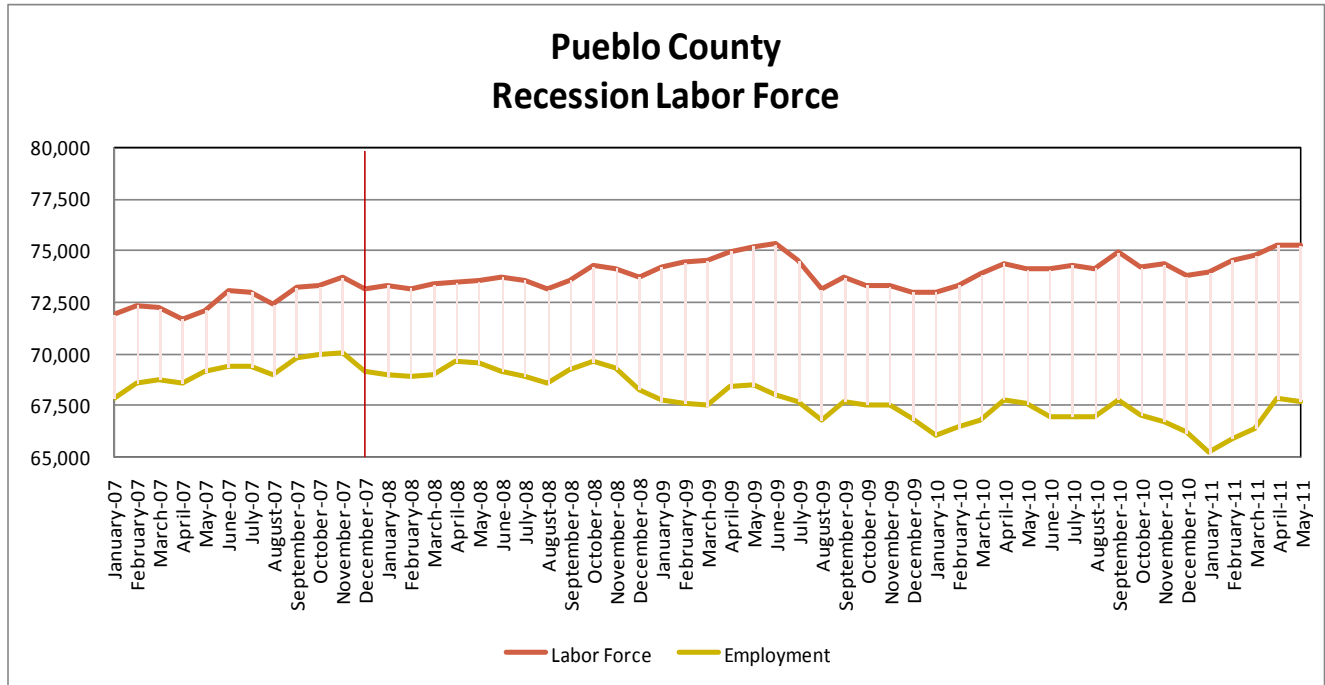
Labor Force Participation Rate

This ratio indicates the degree to which a population is working or actively seeking employment. A low rate might indicate a significant prison population, reliance on other forms of income or a significant number of discouraged workers. A higher rate may indicate a tight labor market. As of June, 2010 the Colorado rate was 68.3% and the National rate as of July, 2010 was 64.6%. Pueblo County's rate as of December, 2010 was 47%.

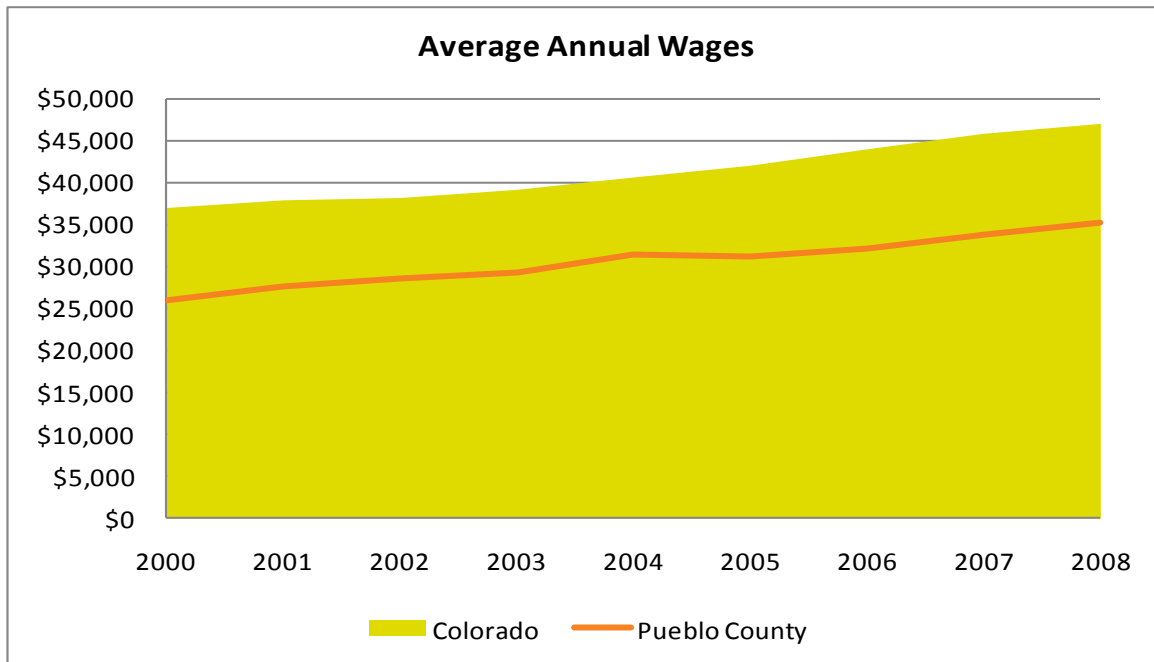
Income and Wages

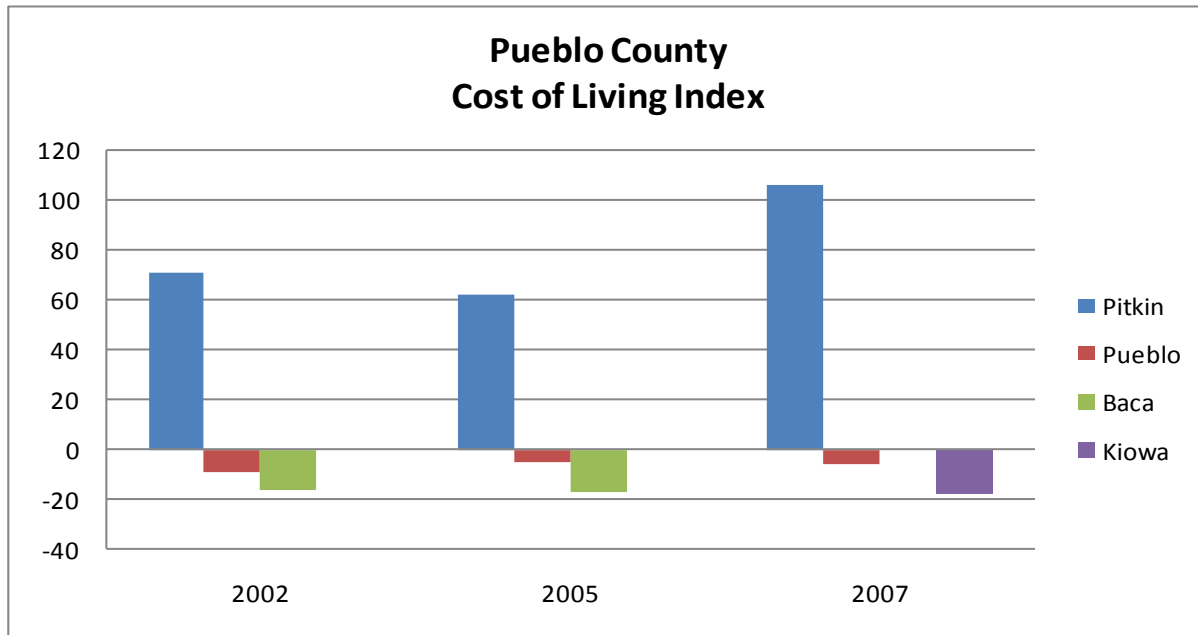

In 2007, Pueblo County had 910,566 acres of agricultural land. There are 881 farms, with an average of 1,034 acres. According to the 2007 Agricultural Census, Pueblo County's largest crop harvested is forage and top livestock is cattle and calves.

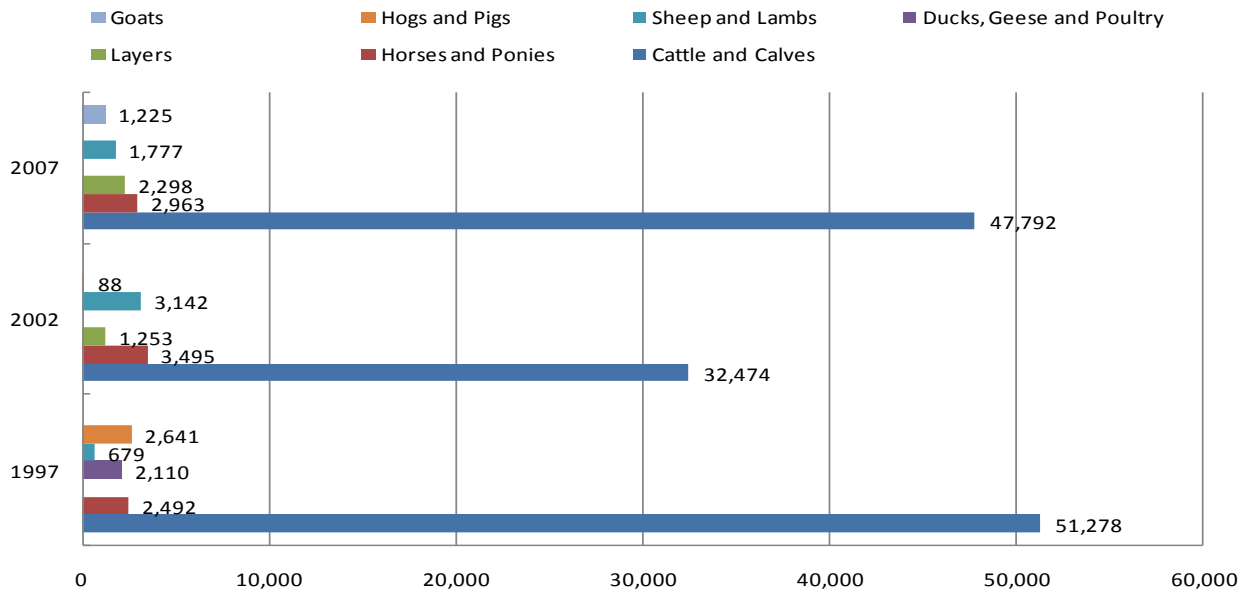
Top Crops Harvested in Acres

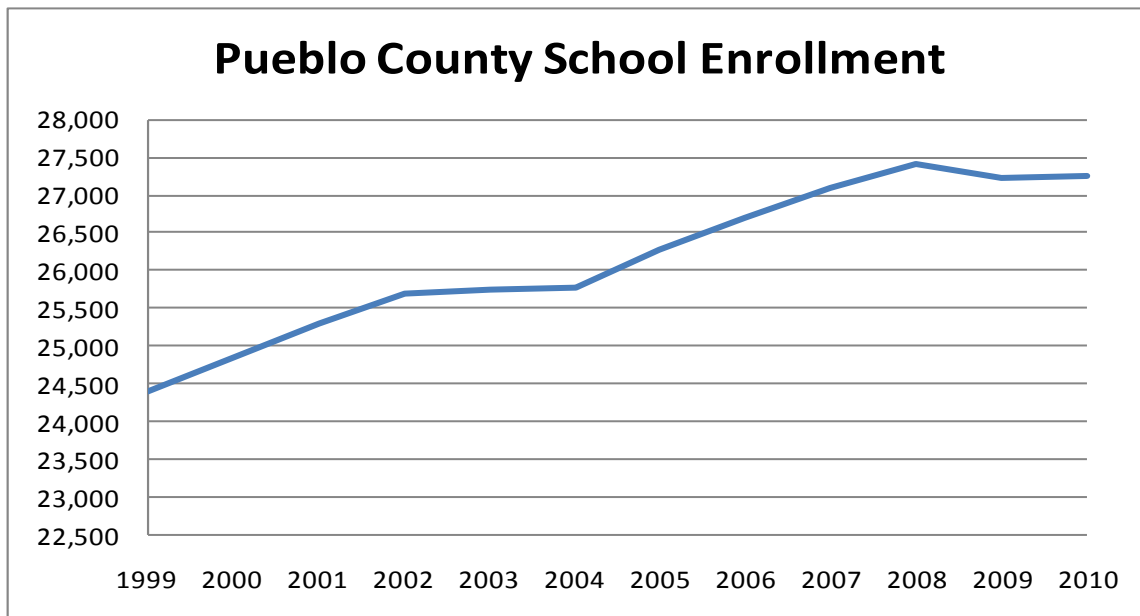

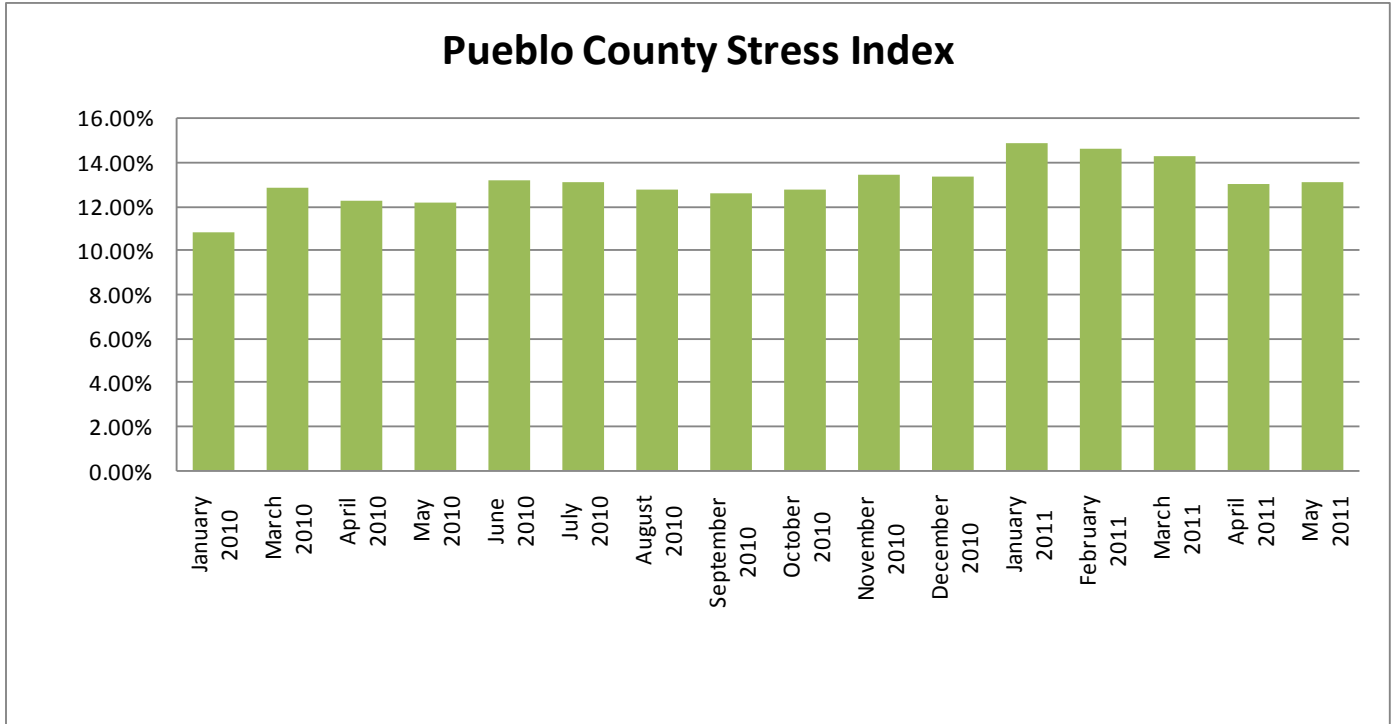

Stress Index



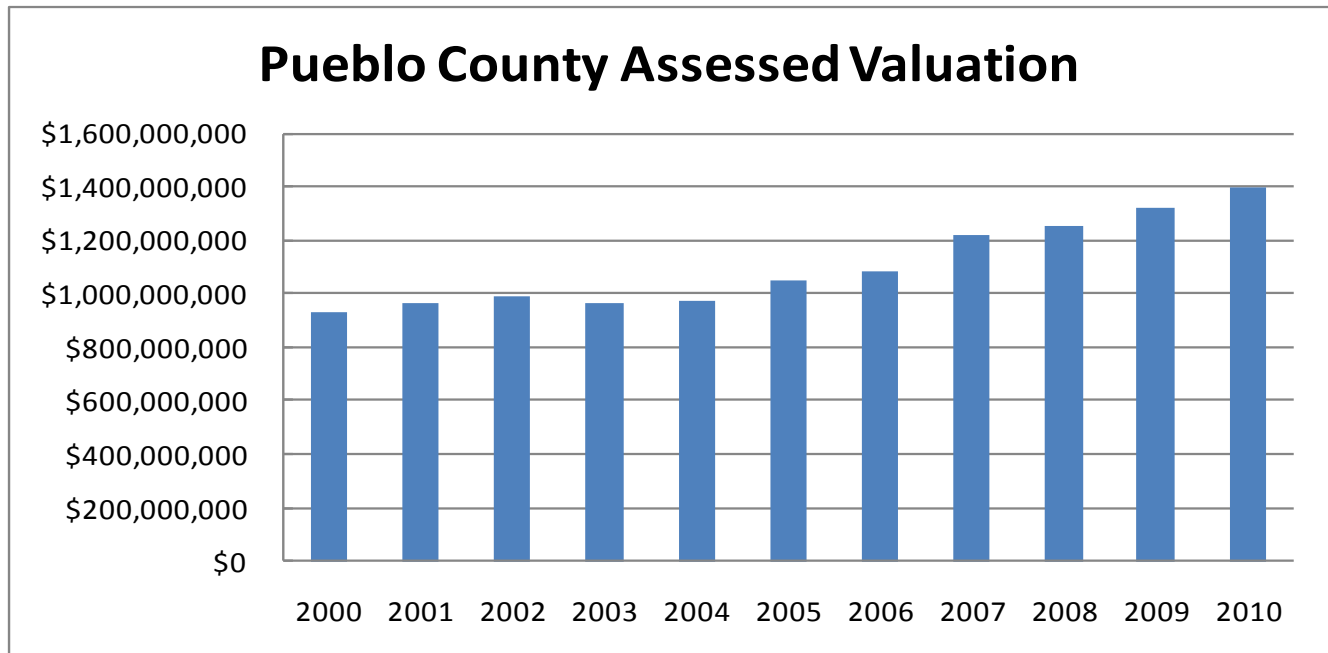
